**Introduction**

The Nodaway-Holt SD R7 is seeking bids for upgrading switching and wireless infrastructure including all related components and initial configuration needed for broadband connectivity within the district.

The district currently has 12 switches and 45 access points in various locations throughout the district, consisting of Aruba, Netgear, HP, and D-link switches. Upgrades to PoE switches to support upgraded Access Points.

**Provide bids for the following items. Installation is not necessary, however there are multiple SSID's in place that will need to be recreated along with some vlan creation for the multiple SSID's as the current network is a flat network and the vlan's reside on the Access points for traffic segregation.**
